SLEAFORD WHEELERS CYCLING CLUB Rules 2013

1. The club shall be known as Sleaford Wheelers Cycling Club followed by the name of sponsor(s) (if any)
2. The Club colours shall be red, blue and white in a design approved by the Committee and members shall (where practicable) wear Club colours at all times and particularly when representing the Club in an event
3. Club membership shall be from 1st February to 31st January in the following year; any person joining on or after 1st October shall not be required to resubscribe for the following year. Any person failing to renew their membership by the end of February shall cease to be a member of the Club from that date
4. The Club shall hold an Annual General Meeting (AGM) in November of each year. Members wishing to put forward motions to the AGM shall give notice in writing to the Secretary at least 14 days before the AGM. Notice of the AGM shall be delivered to all members at least 7 days before the meeting; all fully paid up first claim members shall be eligible to vote and stand for election as Officers of the Club; second claim members may serve on the Committee in other capacities
5. The Club shall be administered by a committee of elected officers comprising a Chairman, Vice chairman, Secretary, Treasurer, Racing Secretary, Webmaster, Social/Entertainments Officer, Press Officer, Young Riders' and Ladies' Representatives, Club Captain(s) and Club Coach(es), and such additional members as are elected at the AGM or co-opted by the Committee
6. The Club's President, Vice President, BC and CTT Representatives shall also be entitled to attend and vote at committee meetings; all other members shall be entitled to attend committee meetings but may not vote
7. The Committee shall have the authority to settle any matter not provided for in the Rules or Regulations and to introduce such new Rules and Regulations as they may think necessary and all members shall abide by those decisions in events (or Club runs) organised by the Club
8. Club subscriptions for the forthcoming year shall be decided at the AGM or by the Committee; the President and Vice President(s) shall be Honorary Members and no payment shall be required
9. Family membership shall be open to a maximum of two adults and all children under 18 years of age (or in full time education) living together as a household; the family may join either as first claim or second claim but all members within the household must have the same level of membership
10. The Club shall promote such racing and social events as shall be decided at the AGM or by the Committee
11. In the event that the conduct of any member is considered detrimental to the interests of the Club, the Committee shall have power to make such decision(s) as considered necessary and it's decision shall be final and binding on that member
12. The Club shall hold a prize presentation event each year. Members shall keep any trophies belonging to the Club in a clean condition and shall return these to the designated official on request; an individual ceasing to be a member of the Club shall be entitled to attend the annual prize presentation and receive any trophy due to him/her, the trophy being returned to the Club at or before the conclusion of the prize presentation
13. Members must obey the law in all club events (including club runs) and when racing obey the rules of the relevant organising body
14. Club runs and tours shall be under the supervision of the club captain or (in his/her absence) by a substitute leader and shall be in accordance with such rules or regulations approved by the Committee
15. All riders shall use a working rear LED light in Club evening time trial events
16. All riders must wear a cycling helmet that meets European safety/manufacturing standard CE EN1078 on all official club runs
17. All racing fees for club events shall be paid before the competitor is allowed to start

Club Regulations

Safety

The Club advises:

1. Members should have 3rd party insurance offered through the CTC (Cyclists' Touring Club) or BC (British Cycling) or other similar organisation
2. Members should not wear earphones, MP3 headphones or similar when riding
3. Members participate in all Club events (including club runs) at their own risk and parents/guardians of children under the age of 16 years should ensure the safety of children under their care

Club Runs

1. The Club shall organise a variety of club runs depending upon the Club's membership but members should recognise it is impracticable to cater for every individual need
2. Instructions from the Club Captain shall be obeyed by all participants
3. Riders shall use mudguards during winter months and in particular during the period October-February

Club Racing

1.
 - 1.1 The Club may offer 'block' payment at a discount to 1st claim members for evening 7-mile and 10-mile leagues and for championship events and all members riding the Club's 7-mile and 10-mile leagues shall be eligible for awards, whether they have 'block' pre-entered or otherwise
 - 1.2 Block entry forms for Club Championship events may be submitted to the Secretary, riders giving their best times at each distance (where relevant) in place of a standard CTT entry form; riders shall advise the Secretary of any improvement in their times at least 3 days before a relevant event is held
2. In the case of 7 and 10 mile leagues a standard CTT entry form must be received by the Racing Secretary at least 7 days prior to the start of the first event in each league accompanied either by the fee for block entry or the fee for the first event being ridden; later entries may be accepted but any even ridden prior to receipt of the entry form will not count towards the league award; members not submitting an entry form may ride as a private trial
3. Where entry to a Club evening event is over-subscribed the Racing Secretary may select competitors based upon the following categories (in order of preference):
 - 3.1 1st claim members having pre-paid entry fees
 - 3.2 Other 1st claim members
 - 3.3 2nd claim members
 - 3.4 Other riders wishing to ride a private trial
4. Where a Club championship is held in conjunction with another event an additional entry form for the Championship (together with payment) shall be sent to the Racing Secretary at least 7 days prior to the start of the event where no block entry form has previously been submitted
5. Club Racing events (and awards) shall include:
 - 5.1 Championship events for time trials, cyclo cross and road racing (either as 'stand alone' events or to be held in conjunction with other events nominated by the Committee)
 - 5.2 Short distance (7-mile) and 10 mile time trial leagues run throughout the season
 - 5.3 Best All Rounder and Points awards
 - 5.4 Riders should submit their BAR claims including times and a copy of the official results sheet to the Racing Secretary before 31st October in each year.
