



Lincolnshire Road Riding Association

The LRRRA was originally formed in 1912. It is an Association made up of cycling clubs in the 'old' county of Lincolnshire (as prior to 01 Apr 1974), which affiliate to the national organisation the CTT (Cycling Time Trials).

The Association promotes a number of events throughout the season, covering the popular Time Trialling distances, to offer a county competition for Lincolnshire cyclists, as well as offering events in Lincolnshire open to all cyclists, run under CTT Regulations.

The LRRRA Club Points Trophy

In 2015 SWCC set out to reclaim the Lincolnshire Road Riding Association Nev Crane Points Trophy. Thanks to massive entries by SWCC members in LRRRA events we not only won back the trophy, we have now won it for three years in succession!

To win this trophy, clubs are awarded points for every rider who enters an LRRRA event, more points for riding the event and further points for being placed in the event. Therefore, the club that wins it is usually the one with the **most** riders entered.

LRRRA Points for 100mile TTs and 12 hour TTs.

In addition to these local events, riders can also earn points for the club when they enter any 100mile and any 12hour TT. If three SWCC members ride the same event there is a chance of getting additional "team points" for the club.

To get the LRRRA points for the club you will need to enter the event in the normal way with the entry fee **and** send a separate entry form with the £5 LRRRA fee to Bryan Hopkinson, 74 Newark Road, North Hykeham, Lincoln, LN6 8NA. You may ride as many 12hour TTs as you like but only pay the £5 once. The same goes for the 100mile TTs too!
