

To all members of SWCC

Good afternoon all,

We hope that you are all keeping well.

Firstly, a huge thank you to all who participated, supported and donated to our lock down charity event helping to raise much needed funds for St Barnabas. Also, to those who have been organising various virtual club events over the past three months. What an amazing and resourceful club we are!!

The SWCC Committee had an online meeting on Monday evening to discuss the new guidelines issued by the various cycling organisations and to consider our position on restarting club activities and events.

- British Cycling issued guidance on 3<sup>rd</sup> June which states that all formalised group and club activity remains suspended until 4<sup>th</sup> July.
- The Go Ride committee are making plans to be ready to re start Go Ride sessions once the government and BC guidance allow this to happen and only if it is thought safe to do so. The area used for our Go ride sessions is very overgrown and Dennis will need some help getting the site ready. **If you are able to help with this, please contact Dennis.**
- Lincs Cyclo-Cross Association are working to plan for a provisional calendar of events for a Cyclo-Cross season beginning in October, but this is a “best case scenario” and are awaiting further guidance before decisions can be made.
- CTT guidance issued on 8<sup>th</sup> June states that all type A “club” events are suspended up to and including 5<sup>th</sup> July while Type A “open” events are suspended up to and including 17<sup>th</sup> July. CTT will review the position following further government guidance which is expected on 4<sup>th</sup> July. SWCC Committee are looking at the Coronavirus Risk Assessment Guidance from CTT and making plans to restart club TTs when government and CTT guidance allows and when it is thought safe to do so.
- Cycling UK guidance dated 1<sup>st</sup> June stated that Cycling UK has taken the decision to allow group riding of up to six people according to government guidance and providing social distancing is maintained. SWCC Committee do not feel this is practical for club rides and will not be organising any Club Rides for the time being.

SWCC Committee will be reviewing our position at the next online committee meeting on Monday 6<sup>th</sup> July. If you have any questions or suggestions that you would like to be raised at the meeting please let us know before then.
