From the Friday morning of **each week**, you will need to sign up using this <u>LINK</u> by 11:59 pm on the Tuesday before the event if you want to ride that week. The form must be completed in full otherwise it won't be submitted, and the data on the form will not be shared externally to the club. The link will also be on a 'Pinned Post' on the club's Facebook Page <u>here</u> once the season is about to start.

CTT Events now run in Open Category (Formerly Male) and Female Category.

The start sheet will be available for **signing on** at the Horseshoes between 6:00 pm and 6:40 pm on Thursday and numbers can be collected then.

- Adult first and second claim members: £4.00.
- Members under 18 years: £3.00
- All Non-Members: £5.00

Members can make a **Block Payment** before the beginning of each series at a discounted price, but please note there will be no refunds for cancelled events, and **you will still need to pre-book your place each week.**
