



Arrangements for SWCC Club 10s 2021.

Everything is just about in place for the coming season of 10's, on our all new 10 course SW10/1 (it's very similar to the old course but has been modified a little due to a section that is in need of some repair). The new course starts a little nearer to the Grantham Road roundabout and finishes a little further back up the hill than it used to. As per current government guidelines we will still be running the events under CTT COVID restrictions, similar to last year but with a physical signing on.

The process is:

1. Register for the events by completing our online registration form here <https://www.chris-close.com/tt-reg.html>. Random numbers will be issued to all who register and will be your number for the whole season, these will NOT be matched to your start times.
2. Payment should be made in advance of each event or by whole season block booking. Details of how to pay here <https://www.chris-close.com/paymentsTT.html>
3. Each week all registered riders will be sent a link to enter the next event. This link will take you to another online form which will let us know that you would like to ride. **This form needs to be completed by 11.59 pm on the Tuesday evening preceding the event.**
4. Each week a startsheet, with your start time, will be published on the website and on our Facebook page.
5. Please **read carefully** the event information here <https://sleafordwheelers.co.uk/Assets/tt-riders.pdf>
6. **Important:** Please do not turn up to the start area more than 5 minutes before your start time, bring your own pen to sign in and keep socially distanced at all times.
7. Results etcetera will be published online after the event.

To enter any of our club TT's, riders between the ages of 12 and 17 will need to complete a [Parental permission form](#) for the season.

All competitors – please be aware of CTT Regulation 14(i):

No competitor shall be permitted to start the event unless such competitor has affixed to the rear of their machine a working rear red light, either flashing or constant, that is illuminated and in a position that is clearly visible to other road users.
